Welcome to Faribault Wrestling and the Green Machine Youth Program! Faribault has a long and proud tradition of excellent wrestling and has produced several all-state and state champion wrestlers and we are excited to include you in this tradition of excellence!

The Faribault Wrestling Club (FWC) has great facilities and excellent youth coaches hired to teach your Lil' Falcon the fundamentals needed to be successful in the great sport of wrestling. The FWC Family will expose children Pre-K through 5th Grade to a fun, competitive, safe, and caring atmosphere filled with opportunities to excel as an individual in a team setting. Coaches focus on building both physical and mental strengths; and teach skills that will aid your child as they enter the Faribault Middle and High School wrestling programs.

Practices will take place in the wrestling room at the Faribault High School every Tuesday and Thursday beginning November 19th. To better assist our athletes we will continue to run two practice sessions.

- **Session I: 5:30pm-6:30pm (PreK-2nd Grade)**
- **Session II: 6:30pm-8:00pm (3rd - 5th Grade)**
 - Wrestlers have an opportunity to compete in weekend individual tournaments throughout the year. This is a great way to “test” skills learned while in practice.
 - Wrestlers also have the opportunity to challenge and compete for a spot on the Green Machine Traveling Team.

Fees:

Please bring four (4) checks made payable to FWC on Saturday, October 26th to be used for:

Check #1: Registration Fee

- PreK – 2nd Grade: \$100
- 3rd – 5th Grade: \$125
 - Fee includes Warm-up Jacket and Shorts which is yours to keep at the end of the season. Fee also includes coach costs, facility use, and team tournament fees.
 - Registration fees do not include the cost to participate in individual tournament. Those cost are usually (\$10-\$12) per event.
 - Scholarships are available. Guidelines are located on our website.

Check #2: Singlet Deposit

- \$100
 - Throughout the season your child will compete in individual and team tournaments. We want our wrestlers to be unified and show strength in numbers and therefor all wrestlers are required to wear the Green Machine Uniform. This check will be shredded upon the return of a complete and clean singlet.

Check #3: Fundraiser Fee

- \$80 per 10 tickets (\$8 each)
 - The Green Machine will participate in a few fundraising projects offered by the FWC, but they are only responsible for selling eight (8) tickets for the American Legion Burger Basket held on Friday, November 22nd 5:00-7:30pm.
 - Families will need to write a check for \$80 to receive their ten tickets. Sell the tickets, keep the money. Your check for \$80 will not be cashed until December 1st, 2019

Check #4: Volunteer Security Deposit

- \$175
 - Pre-K – 2nd Grade: 4 Required Hours
 - 3rd – 5th Grade: 6 Required Hours
 - In order for FWC to run an efficient and effective program, we need your help! FWC is run completely by volunteers and we need the support of our families in order to make everything run smoothly. From tournaments, to fundraising...we need you!
 - This check will be shredded upon the completion (acknowledged via email) of your allotted hours. Parents with multiple wrestlers are only required to fulfill the hours of their eldest wrestler. Payment of the deposit acknowledges and accepts the terms listed on the Volunteer Form.
